- Are police checked
- Are trained in safety and ethical practice.
- Follow the Ara Taiohi Code of Ethics
- Follow our Church's Health and Safety Policies
- Are aware of their responsibilities to themselves, their fellow leaders, children, young people and wider community.
- Keep parents/guardians fully informed of their child's activities and require consent when appropriate.
- Identify and monitor hazards within our facilities.
- Record all incidents, near misses or injury.
- Clearly inform children and young people about accident and emergency procedures in place
